1.8	Subd. 2. <b>Program components.</b> (a) The nonprofit organization must use the grant for:
1.9	(1) tuition scholarships up to $\$5,000 \ \$10,000$ per year for courses leading to the nationally
1.10	recognized child development associate credential or college-level courses leading to an
1.11	associate's or bachelor's degree in early childhood development and school-age care; and
1.12	(2) education incentives of a minimum of $\$100 \ \$250$ to participants in the tuition
1.13	scholarship program if they complete a year of working in the early care and education
1.14	field.
1.15	(b) Applicants for the scholarship must be employed by a licensed early childhood or
1.16	child care program and working directly with children, a licensed family child care provider,
