1.8	(1) a person driving a passenger vehicle in reverse;
1.9	(2) a person riding in a vehicle in which all the seating positions equipped with safety
1.10	belts are occupied by other persons in safety belts;
1.11	(3) a person who is in possession of a written certificate from a licensed physician
1.12	verifying that because of medical unfitness or physical disability the person is unable to
1.13	wear a seat belt;
1.14	(4) a person who is actually engaged in work that requires the person to alight from and
1.15	reenter a motor vehicle at frequent intervals and who, while engaged in that work, does not
1.16	drive or travel in that vehicle at a speed exceeding 25 miles per hour;
