

A bill for an act

relating to occupations and professions; modifying deposit requirements for cosmetology license payments; amending Minnesota Statutes 2009 Supplement, section 155A.25, subdivision 1.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2009 Supplement, section 155A.25, subdivision 1, is amended to read:

Subdivision 1. **Schedule.** The fee schedule for licensees is as follows:

(a) Three-year license fees:

(1) cosmetologist, manicurist, esthetician, \$90 for each initial license, and \$60 for each renewal;

(2) instructor, manager, \$120 for each initial license, and \$90 for each renewal;

(3) salon, \$130 for each initial license, and \$100 for each renewal; and

(4) school, \$1,500.

(b) Penalties:

(1) reinspection fee, variable;

(2) manager and owner with lapsed practitioner, \$150 each;

(3) expired cosmetologist, manicurist, esthetician, manager, school manager, and instructor license, \$45; and

(4) expired salon or school license, \$50.

(c) Administrative fees:

(1) certificate of identification, \$20;

(2) school original application, \$150;

(3) name change, \$20;

2.1 (4) letter of license verification, \$30;

2.2 (5) duplicate license, \$20;

2.3 (6) processing fee, \$10; and

2.4 (7) special event permit, \$75 per year.

2.5 (d) All fees established in this subdivision must be paid to the executive secretary
2.6 of the board. The executive secretary of the board shall deposit the fees in the general
2.7 fund in the state treasury.

2.8 (e) The executive secretary of the board must not deposit any check used to pay for a
2.9 fee under paragraph (a) until after the license or certificate has been issued or renewed.

2.10 For the purposes of this paragraph, the term "check" has the meaning given it in section
2.11 604.113.
