The network must 1 10 connect Minnesota entrepreneurs to available state and nonstate supported services and 1 11 technical assistance. In developing and maintaining the network, OESBD must ensure that 1.12 all listed resources meet established standards. The goal of the network is to assist in the 1.13 creation of new Minnesota ventures, the growth of existing businesses, and the ability 1.14 of Minnesota entrepreneurs to compete globally. To the greatest extent possible, the 1.15 network should be built on and linked to existing resources designed to make business 1.16 assistance resources more accessible to Minnesota business.
