1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to capital investment; appropriating money for drinking water infrastructure
1.3 in the city of Aurora; authorizing the sale and issuance of state bonds.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. DRINKING WATER SYSTEM FOR AURORA; HOYT LAKES;
1.6 BIWABIK; AND WHITE TOWNSHIP.

1.7 Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$8,600,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund
1.8 to the Public Facilities Authority for a grant to the city of Aurora to acquire land or a
1.9 permanent interest in land, design, engineer, construct, furnish, and equip a comprehensive
1.10 municipally owned cooperative joint drinking water system in the cities of Aurora, Hoyt
1.11 Lakes, and Biwabik, and White Township, including a water intake and treatment plant
1.12 located in White Township. This appropriation is available when the commissioner of
1.13 management and budget determines that sufficient resources have been committed to
1.14 complete the project, as required by Minnesota Statutes, section 16A.502.

1.15 Subd. 2. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond
1.16 proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of
1.17 the state in an amount up to \$8,600,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect
1.18 prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota
1.19 Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.

1.20 EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.
