The bill was read for the first time and referred to the Committee on Commerce and Consumer Protection Finance and Policy

1.1 A bill for an act  
1.2 relating to liquor; allowing sale of growlers by off-sale and on-sale licensees.  
1.3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.4 Section 1. **GROWLER SALES EXPANSION; TEST PERIOD.**

1.5 A holder of an on-sale or off-sale license may sell growlers of intoxicating malt  
1.6 liquor, as described in Minnesota Statutes, section 340A.301, subdivision 6d, to patrons  
1.7 under the following conditions:

1.8 (1) all sales must be during normal hours of operation;  
1.9 (2) sales must be from types of intoxicating malt liquor not otherwise available in  
1.10 cans or bottles; and  
1.11 (3) all applicable requirements of Minnesota Statutes, chapter 340A, must be met.

1.12 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective on July 1, 2014, and sunsets on  
1.13 June 30, 2018.
