1.1 A bill for an act  
1.2 relating to education; providing for nutrition policy; appropriating money;  
1.3 amending Minnesota Statutes 2012, section 124D.111, subdivision 1, by adding  
1.4 a subdivision.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2012, section 124D.111, subdivision 1, is amended to  
1.7 read:

1.8 Subdivision 1. **School lunch aid computation.** Each school year, the state must  
1.9 pay participants in the national school lunch program the amount of 12 cents for each full  
1.10 paid, ~~reduced,~~ and free student lunch and 52 cents for each reduced-price student lunch  
1.11 served to students.

1.12 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective for fiscal year 2014 and thereafter.

1.13 Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 2012, section 124D.111, is amended by adding a  
1.14 subdivision to read:

1.15 Subd. 4. **No fees.** A participant that receives school lunch aid under this section  
1.16 must make lunch available without charge to all participating students who qualify for free  
1.17 or reduced-price meals.

1.18 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective for fiscal year 2014 and thereafter.

1.19 Sec. 3. **APPROPRIATIONS.**

2.1            Subdivision 1. **Department of Education.** The sums indicated in this section are  
 2.2 appropriated from the general fund to the Department of Education for the fiscal years  
 2.3 designated.

2.4            Subd. 2. **School lunch.** For school lunch aid according to Minnesota Statutes,  
 2.5 section 124D.111, and Code of Federal Regulations, title 7, section 210.17:
