1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to health; creating an exemption to the prohibition of minors using
1.3 tanning equipment at a tanning facility for medical reasons; amending Minnesota
1.4 Statutes 2014, section 325H.085.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2014, section 325H.085, is amended to read:

1.7 **325H.085 USE BY MINORS PROHIBITED.**

1.8 (a) A person under age 18 may not use any type of tanning equipment as defined by
1.9 section 325H.01, subdivision 6, available in a tanning facility in this state.

1.10 (b) Notwithstanding paragraph (a), a person under the age of 18 may use tanning
1.11 equipment at a tanning facility if the person has documentation signed by a health care
1.12 provider indicating a medical need for the person to use the tanning equipment for
1.13 purposes of treating a medical or mental condition or disorder, and the person's parent or
1.14 legal guardian signs a consent form prior to the initial exposure at the tanning facility.

1.15 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
