The bill was read for the first time and referred to the Committee on Environment and Natural Resources Finance and Policy

1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to natural resources; appropriating money for all-terrain vehicle trails.
1.3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.4 Section 1. APPROPRIATION; VOYAGEUR COUNTRY ATV TRAIL.

1.5 \$500,000 in fiscal year 2023 is appropriated from the all-terrain vehicle account in the
1.6 natural resources fund to the commissioner of natural resources for a grant to St. Louis
1.7 County to match other funding sources for design, right-of-way acquisition, permitting, and
1.8 construction of trails within the Voyageur Country ATV trail system. This is a onetime
1.9 appropriation and is available until June 30, 2025. This appropriation may be used as a local
1.10 match to a 2022 state bonding award.

1.11 Sec. 2. APPROPRIATION; PROSPECTOR LOOP TRAIL; CITY OF ELY.

1.12 \$500,000 in fiscal year 2023 is appropriated from the all-terrain vehicle account in the
1.13 natural resources fund to the commissioner of natural resources for a grant to St. Louis
1.14 County to match other funding sources for design, right-of-way acquisition, permitting, and
1.15 construction of a new trail within the Prospector trail system. This is a onetime appropriation
1.16 and is available until June 30, 2025. This appropriation may be used as a local match to a
1.17 2022 state bonding award.

1.18 EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.
