1.5	Section 1. CONTRACT REQUIRED FOR CERTAIN INFORMATION
1.6	TECHNOLOGY PROJECTS.
1.7	The commissioner of health must enter a contract with one or more vendors for the
1.8	development and completion of an information and telecommunications technology project
1.9	with a total expected cost of more than \$1,000,000. The contract must be solicited, awarded,
1.10	and executed according to the requirements of Minnesota Statutes, chapter 16C.
1.11	Notwithstanding Minnesota Statutes, section 16C.08, subdivision 2, a competitive proposal
1.12	process must be used for professional and technical services related to a project subject to
1.13	this section, regardless of whether a current state agency employee is able and available to
1.14	perform the services called for by the contract. The state chief information officer may
1.15	submit a proposal in response to a solicitation required by this section.
