- 1.2 relating to liquor; authorizing the issuance of malt liquor and wine licenses to
- 1.3 certain retailers currently licensed to sell 3.2 beer.
- 1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
- 1.5 Section 1. **EXISTING 3.2 PERCENT MALT LIQUOR LICENSES.**
- 1.6 (a) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, by the effective date of this section, the
- 1.7 governing body of a city or county shall issue to a seasonal resort owner who is currently
- 1.8 licensed under Minnesota Statutes, section 340A.403, subdivision 1, for the off-sale of 3.2
- 1.9 percent malt liquor, a license for the off-sale of malt liquor and a license for the off-sale of
- 1.10 wine.
- 1.11 (b) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, by the effective date of this section, the
- 1.12 governing body of a city or county shall issue to a seasonal resort owner who is currently
- 1.13 licensed under Minnesota Statutes, section 340A.403, subdivision 1, for the on-sale of 3.2
- 1.14 percent malt liquor, a license for the on-sale of malt liquor and a license for the on-sale of
- 1.15 wine.
- 1.16 (c) All other provisions of Minnesota Statutes, chapter 340A, not inconsistent with this
- 1.17 section, apply to the issuance of a license under this section.
- 1.18 (d) For purposes of this section, a "seasonal resort owner" means a person who owns
- 1.19 and operates a seasonal resort, within the meaning of Minnesota Statutes, section 273.13,
- 1.20 subdivision 22, paragraph (b).
- 1.21 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective
