.6	Section 1. PERPICH CENTER FOR ARTS EDUCATION.
.7	Subdivision 1. Appropriation. (a) \$4,000,000 is appropriated from the bond
.8	proceeds fund to the commissioner of administration for capital asset preservation
.9	improvements and betterments at the Perpich Center for Arts Education, to be spent in
.10	accordance with Minnesota Statutes, section 16B.307.
.11	(b) \$100,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund to the commissioner of
.12	administration to predesign an auditorium expansion to accommodate the full student
.13	body and faculty, a lobby expansion and renovation to address security, restroom needs
.14	and accessibility issues, a new library building, remodeling of food service cafeteria,

.16	Subd. 2. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in this section from the
