1.7	Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$2,050,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund
1.8	to the commissioner of transportation for a grant to the city of Arden Hills for property and
1.9	easement acquisition, design, and construction of a pedestrian and bicycle trail along Old
1.10	Highway 10 North, from Lake Valentine Road to Lakeshore Place, to connect to the existing
1.11	regional trail along County State-Aid Highway 96.
1.12	Subd. 2. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond
1.13	proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of
1.14	the state in an amount up to \$2,050,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect
