1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to capital investment; appropriating money for cleanup of the Waste
1.3 Disposal Engineering (WDE) closed landfill site in Anoka County; authorizing
1.4 the sale and issuance of state bonds.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. CLOSED LANDFILL CLEANUP; WDE CLOSED LANDFILL.

1.7 Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$6,000,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund
1.8 to the Pollution Control Agency to design and construct remedial systems, including cleanup
1.9 and removal of a leaking hazardous waste pit and protection of groundwater, at the Waste
1.10 Disposal Engineering (WDE) site in Anoka County in accordance with the closed landfill
1.11 program under Minnesota Statutes, sections 115B.39 to 115B.42.

1.12 Subd. 2. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond
1.13 proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of
1.14 the state in an amount up to \$6,000,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect
1.15 prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota
1.16 Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.

1.17 EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.
