1.5	Section 1. MOUNDS VIEW HIGH SCHOOL TRAIL SEGMENTS; ARDEN HILLS
1.6	Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$2,500,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund
1.7	to the commissioner of transportation for a grant to the city of Arden Hills to acquire
1.8	easements, design, and construct paved pedestrian and bike trails along Lake Valentine
1.9	Road from Mounds View High School to Old Snelling Road and along Old Snelling Road
1.10	from Lake Valentine Road to County Road E2 in the city of Arden Hills. This appropriation
