1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 13.32, subdivision 5a, is amended to read:

1.7 Subd. 5a. **Military recruitment.** (a) A secondary institution shall release to military
1.8 recruiting officers the names, addresses, and ~~home~~ telephone numbers of students in grades
1.9 11 and 12 within 60 days after the date of the request, except as otherwise provided by this
1.10 subdivision. A secondary institution shall ~~give parents and students notice~~ provide notice
1.11 to each student and parent or guardian of each student, in accordance with federal law, of
1.12 the right to refuse release of this data the release of the student's name, address, and telephone
1.13 numbers to military recruiting officers. ~~Notice may be given by any means reasonably likely~~
1.14 ~~to inform the parents and students of the right.~~

1.15 Data released to military recruiting officers under this subdivision:

1.16 (1) may be used only for the purpose of providing information to students about military
1.17 service, state and federal veterans' education benefits, and other career and educational
1.18 opportunities provided by the military; and

1.19 (2) shall not be further disseminated to any other person except personnel of the recruiting
1.20 services of the armed forces.

1.21 (b) The notice required by paragraph (a) shall:

- 2.1 (1) be clear, conspicuous, and in the same format and size type as other statements on
2.2 the card or form requesting emergency contact information that is distributed by the
2.3 secondary institution to each student or parent or guardian of the student; and
- 2.4 (2) inform and request the student or parent or guardian of the student to indicate if the
2.5 student's name, address, and telephone numbers should not be released to military recruiting
2.6 officers by clearly checking the box entitled "Do Not Release Contact Information."
