The bill was read for the first time and referred to the Committee on Transportation Finance and Policy

- 1.1 A bill for an act
- 1.2 relating to motor vehicles; requiring a report examining a transition to digital driver
- 1.3 and vehicle documents.
- 1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
- 1.5 Section 1. **REPORT; TRANSITION TO DIGITAL TITLES AND DRIVERS'**
- 1.6 **LICENSES.**
- 1.7 By December 15, 2022, the commissioner of public safety must report to the chairs and
- 1.8 ranking minority members of the legislative committees with jurisdiction over transportation
- 1.9 policy and finance on transitioning from physical driver and vehicle documents to digital
- 1.10 versions of the same documents. At a minimum, the report must:
- 1.11 (1) include information on how other states have implemented the transition to digital
- 1.12 documents;
- 1.13 (2) make recommendations on how to ensure the security, integrity, and privacy of data;
- 1.14 (3) include an estimate of the costs for transitioning to digital documents;
- 1.15 (4) include an estimated timeline for transitioning to digital documents; and
- 1.16 (5) identify statutory changes necessary to implement the transition to digital documents.
- 1.17 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective August 1, 2022.
