1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to capital investment; appropriating money for a recreation and education
1.3 building for the Prairie Lakes Youth Program in Kandiyohi County; authorizing
1.4 the sale and issuance of state bonds.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. PRAIRIE LAKES YOUTH PROGRAM; KANDIYOHI COUNTY.

1.7 Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$1,670,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund
1.8 to the commissioner of human services for a grant to Kandiyohi County to predesign, design,
1.9 construct, furnish, and equip an indoor recreation and educational building adjoining the
1.10 current building for the Prairie Lakes Youth Program. This appropriation is not available
1.11 until the commissioner of management and budget determines that at least \$500,000 has
1.12 been committed from nonstate sources to complete the project.

1.13 Subd. 2. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond
1.14 proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of
1.15 the state in an amount up to \$1,670,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect
1.16 prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota
1.17 Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.

1.18 EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.
