The bill was read for the first time and referred to the Committee on Housing Finance and Policy

- 1.1 A bill for an act
- 1.2 relating to housing; appropriating money for a grant to Community Stabilization
- 1.3 Project for services to renters and property owners in low-income and
- 1.4 underrepresented communities.
- 1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
- 1.6 Section 1. **APPROPRIATION.**
- 1.7 \$295,000 in fiscal year 2023 is appropriated from the general fund to the Minnesota
- 1.8 Housing Finance Agency for a grant to Community Stabilization Project. Of this amount:
- 1.9 (1) \$100,000 is to continue the Community Stabilization Project's work of delivering
- 1.10 holistic person-centered services and curriculum to renters and property owners in order to
- 1.11 preserve deeply affordable rental units in underrepresented communities. This amount is
- 1.12 available until expended. \$100,000 is added to the base in fiscal year 2024 and \$0 in fiscal
- 1.13 year 2025 for this purpose;
- 1.14 (2) \$120,000 is to expand the creation of entry level employment opportunities for renters
- 1.15 to fill in gaps in income and provide stabilization. \$120,000 is added to the base in fiscal
- 1.16 year 2024 and \$0 in fiscal year 2025 for this purpose; and
- 1.17 (3) \$75,000 is to construct a locker space to secure the valuable verification documents
- 1.18 needed to secure shelter, housing, and identification for those experiencing homelessness.
- 1.19 This amount is available until expended.
