The bill was read for the first time and referred to the Capital Investment Division

- 1.1 A bill for an act
- 1.2 relating to capital investment; appropriating money to extend the Shorewood Park
- 1.3 Sanitary Sewer District sewer system to Rush Lake and expand treatment facilities
- 1.4 in Chisago County; authorizing the sale and issuance of state bonds.
- 1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
- 1.6 Section 1. **SANITARY SEWER SYSTEM EXPANSION AND IMPROVEMENTS;**
- 1.7 **CHISAGO COUNTY.**
- 1.8 Subdivision 1. **Appropriation; expansion of sewer system.** \$700,000 is appropriated
- 1.9 from the bond proceeds fund to the Public Facilities Authority for a grant to Chisago County
- 1.10 to predesign, design, and construct an extension of the Shorewood Park Sanitary Sewer
- 1.11 District sewer system to 20 homes on Rush Lake. This appropriation is not available until
- 1.12 the commissioner of management and budget determines that sufficient resources have been
- 1.13 committed from nonstate sources to complete the project.
- 1.14 Subd. 2. **Appropriation; treatment pond.** \$1,000,000 is appropriated from the bond
- 1.15 proceeds fund to the Public Facilities Authority for a grant to Chisago County to acquire
- 1.16 property and to predesign, design, construct, furnish, and equip a sewage treatment pond
- 1.17 in Chisago County for the Shorewood Park Sanitary Sewer District sewer system. This
- 1.18 appropriation is not available until the commissioner of management and budget determines
- 1.19 that sufficient resources have been committed from nonstate sources to complete the project.
- 1.20 Subd. 3. **Bond sale.** To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond
- 1.21 proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of
- 1.22 the state in an amount up to \$1,700,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect

- 2.1 prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota
- 2.2 Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.
- 2.3 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
