1.7	person may not harvest, buy, sell, transport, or possess aquatic plants without a license
1.8	required under this chapter. A license shall be issued in the same manner as provided under
1.9	the game and fish laws.
1.10	(b) A resident under the age of 18 years may harvest wild rice without a license, if
1.11	accompanied by a person with a wild rice license.
1.12	(c) Tribal band members who possess a valid tribal identification card from a federally
1.13	recognized tribe located in Minnesota are deemed to have a license to harvest wild rice
