1.8	Subd. 7. Annual report by commissioner. (a) Beginning November 1, 2001, and
1.9	each November 1 thereafter, the commissioner shall issue an annual report on county and
1.10	state use of available resources for the home and community-based waiver for persons with
1.11	developmental disabilities. For each county or county partnership, the report shall include
1.12	(1) the amount of funds allocated but not used;
1.13	(2) the county specific allowed reserve amount approved and used;
1.14	(3) the number, ages, and living situations of individuals screened and waiting for
1.15	services;
1.16	(4) the urgency of need for services to begin within one, two, or more than two
1.17	years for each individual;
