1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to the state lottery; providing for restrictions on certain types of lottery
1.3 sales; amending Minnesota Statutes 2014, section 349A.13.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2014, section 349A.13, is amended to read:

1.6 **349A.13 RESTRICTIONS.**

1.7 Nothing in this chapter:

1.8 (1) authorizes the director to conduct a lottery game or contest the winner or winners
1.9 of which are determined by the result of a sporting event other than a horse race conducted
1.10 under chapter 240;

1.11 (2) authorizes the director to install or operate a lottery device operated by coin or
1.12 currency which when operated determines the winner of a game; ~~and~~

1.13 (3) authorizes the director to sell pull-tabs as defined under section 349.12,
1.14 subdivision 32; and

1.15 (4) authorizes the director to offer the play of, on an electronic terminal, through a
1.16 Web site, or by any other means or device, casino-style games, including but not limited to
1.17 blackjack, craps, keno, dice games, roulette, or poker; and

1.18 (5) authorizes the director to offer new delivery methods for selling a lottery game,
1.19 unless authorized by the legislature.

1.20 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
