The bill was read for the first time and referred to the Committee on Government Operations and Elections Policy

1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to state government; requiring a report on potential cost savings from
1.3 remodeling the State Office Building to minimize office moves.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. REPORT ON COST SAVINGS FROM POTENTIAL STATE OFFICE
1.6 BUILDING REMODELING.

1.7 (a) The commissioner of administration, in consultation with the speaker and
1.8 minority leader of the house of representatives, must report to the legislature by October
1.9 15, 2015, on the estimated cost of remodeling the State Office Building to:

- 1.10 (1) place the majority leadership offices on the third floor; and
1.11 (2) make other changes that would minimize the need for members to move offices,
1.12 and that would minimize the costs associated with those moves, when the majority of the
1.13 house of representatives changes from one party to the other party.

1.14 (b) The report must include an estimate of cost savings that would occur each
1.15 biennium that the house of representatives majority changes, as a result of the remodeling
1.16 described in paragraph (a).
