1.6	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
1.7	Section 1. WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT PLAN; MENTAL HEALTH
1.8	ISSUES SUMMIT.
1.9	The Board of Trustees of the Minnesota State Colleges and Universities, in
1.10	cooperation with the commissioner of human services, shall convene a summit of
1.11	representatives of the Minnesota State Colleges and Universities, the University of
1.12	Minnesota, private colleges, mental health professionals, special education, mental health
1.13	advocates, mental health providers, and community mental health centers. The summit
1.14	shall develop a comprehensive workforce development plan to:
1.15	(1) increase the number of mental health professionals and practitioners;
1.16	(2) ensure appropriate course work and training experience; and
1.17	(3) increase the number of culturally diverse mental health professionals and
1.18	practitioners.
1.19	The plan required by this section shall be submitted to the chairs of the legislative
1.20	committees responsible for health and human services policy and higher education policy
1.21	no later than January 15, 2015.
