1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. **[122A.261] PREKINDERGARTEN, SCHOOL READINESS,**

1.7 **PRESCHOOL, AND EARLY EDUCATION PROGRAMS; LICENSURE**

1.8 **REQUIREMENT.**

1.9 Subdivision 1. **Licensure requirement.** A school district or charter school must employ

1.10 a qualified teacher, as defined in section 122A.16, to provide instruction in a preschool,

1.11 school readiness, school readiness plus, prekindergarten, or other school district or charter

1.12 school-based early education program.

1.13 Subd. 2. **Exemptions.** A person employed by a school district or charter school as a

1.14 teacher in an early education program during the 2020-2021 school year who does not have

1.15 a Minnesota teaching license is exempt from the licensure requirement until July 1, 2026,

1.16 or until such time as the teacher is able to obtain a Minnesota teaching license, whichever

1.17 occurs first. Notwithstanding this exemption from the licensure requirement, these individuals

1.18 are teachers under section 179A.03, subdivision 18.
