1.9	private sale to the adjoining landowner the tax-forfeited lands bordering public waters
1.10	that are described in paragraph (c), under the remaining provisions of Minnesota Statutes,
1.11	chapter 282.
1.12	(b) The conveyances must be in a form approved by the attorney general. The
1.13	attorney general may make necessary changes to the legal descriptions to correct errors
1.14	and ensure accuracy.
