1.6	Section 1. MINNESOTA HMONG-LAO VETERANS COMMEMORATIVE

1.8	Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$500,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds
1.9	fund to the commissioner of administration to complete design and construction of a
1.10	memorial in the Capitol Area to honor all Hmong-Lao veterans of the war in Laos who
1.11	were allied with the American forces during the Vietnam War. This appropriation is
1.12	not available until the commissioner of management and budget has determined that at
1.13	least \$150,000 has been committed to the project from nonstate sources. Nonstate funds
1.14	provided for this project may also be used to fund only its proportional share of new
1.15	sidewalks leading to monuments in the Capitol Area.
