1.10	(1) be 18 years of age or older;
1.11	(2) be a citizen of the United States; and
1.12	(3) maintain residence in Minnesota for 20 days immediately preceding the election.
1.13	(b) Notwithstanding paragraph (a), clause (1), an individual who has not reached 18
1.14	years of age but who meets all other eligibility requirements for voting may cast a ballot at
1.15	a primary election or presidential nomination primary, for purposes of nominating candidates
1.16	to be voted on at the subsequent general election, if the individual will be 18 years of age
