BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION.

\$175,000 in fiscal year 2022 and \$175,000 in fiscal year 2023 are appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner of agriculture for compensation for destroyed or crippled livestock under Minnesota Statutes, section 3.737. If the amount appropriated for fiscal year 2022 is insufficient, the amount appropriated for fiscal year 2023 is available to the commissioner in fiscal year 2022. The commissioner may use up to \$5,000 of the 1.10 appropriation each year to reimburse expenses incurred by university extension agents to 1.11 provide the fair market value of destroyed or crippled livestock. 1.12
