1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to state government; providing an exemption for religious beliefs for
1.3 entities providing certain services; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota
1.4 Statutes, chapter 604.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. [604.0551] EXEMPTION FOR RELIGIOUS BELIEFS.

1.7 Notwithstanding chapter 363A or any law to the contrary, no person, organization, or
1.8 entity shall incur a civil or criminal penalty for refusing to provide a service, or refusing to
1.9 allow the use of property or facilities for any activity that is prohibited by or is against the
1.10 person's, organization's, or entity's sincerely held religious beliefs.
