- (a) \$10,000,000 in fiscal year 2024 is appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner of the Minnesota Housing Finance Agency to fund grants under this section.
- (b) The funding under this section may be used for grants to nonprofit organizations to assist manufactured home park residents in organizing and purchasing manufactured home parks, and for grants to provide down payment assistance to residents to purchase manufactured home parks.
- (c) The agency may develop criteria for grant requests under this section. Within 90 days of final enactment, the commissioner shall develop the forms, applications, and reporting requirements for use by eligible organizations. In developing these materials, the commissioner shall consult with manufactured housing cooperatives, resident-owned manufactured home communities, and nonprofit organizations working with manufactured housing cooperatives and resident-owned communities.
- (d) Grantees must use funds to assist in the creation and preservation of housing that is affordable to households with incomes at or below 80 percent of the greater of state or area median income.
- (e) A deed purchased with a grant under this section must contain a covenant running
 with the land requiring that the land be used as a manufactured home park for 30 years from
 the date of purchase.
