

A bill for an act
relating to human services; modifying health care program renewal notice
requirements; amending Minnesota Statutes 2008, section 256.962, subdivision
7.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2008, section 256.962, subdivision 7, is amended to read:

Subd. 7. **Renewal notice.** (a) Beginning December 1, ~~2007~~ 2009, the commissioner shall mail a renewal notice to enrollees notifying the enrollees that the enrollees eligibility must be renewed. A notice shall be sent ~~at least 90 days prior to the renewal date and~~ at least 60 days prior to the renewal date. The notice to enrollees shall explain that its purpose is to provide them with sufficient time to schedule medical appointments that may be required as part of an eligibility renewal. The commissioner shall provide an opt-out form with the first renewal notice to allow enrollees to choose to no longer receive renewal notices.

(b) For enrollees who are receiving services through managed care plans, the managed care plan must provide a follow-up renewal call at least 60 days prior to the enrollees' renewal dates.

(c) The commissioner shall include the end of coverage dates on the monthly rosters of enrollees provided to managed care organizations.
