OFFICIAL STATUS

1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to liquor; authorizing the city of St. Paul to issue an off-sale intoxicating
1.3 liquor license to a hotel that formerly held an off-sale license.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. ST. PAUL; OFF-SALE LICENSE.

1.6 Notwithstanding Minnesota Statutes, section 340A.405, subdivision 1, paragraph (b),
1.7 the city of St. Paul may issue an off-sale intoxicating liquor license to a hotel located at 350
1.8 Market Street that formerly held an off-sale license as of March 1, 2018.

1.9 EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective upon approval by the St. Paul City
1.10 Council and compliance with Minnesota Statutes, section 645.021.
