[10.556] AMERICAN INDIAN AND INDIGENOUS PEOPLES DAY. 1.5 Subdivision 1. **Observance.** The second Monday in October shall be known as American 1.6 Indian and Indigenous Peoples Day to acknowledge and promote the well-being and growth 1.7 of Minnesota's American Indian and Indigenous community. American Indian and Indigenous 1.8 Peoples Day shall be used to reflect upon the ongoing struggles of indigenous people in this 1.9 state, and to celebrate the thriving culture and value that Dakota, Ojibwe, and other 1 10 indigenous nations add to our state. 1.11 Subd. 2. **State recognition.** The state recognizes the annexation of Dakota and Ojibwe 1.12 homelands for the building of our state and recognizes that American Indian and Indigenous 1.13 nations have lived upon this land since time immemorial and the state values the progress 1 14 our society has accomplished through American Indian culture, knowledge, technology, 1.15 and thought. The state has a strong history of collaboration with American Indian tribes and 1.16 indigenous communities in solving pressing issues for American Indian tribes and indigenous 1.17 communities. 1.18 Subd. 3. **Disparities.** The state understands that in order to close persistent and pervasive 1.19 disparities, government entities, organizations, and other public and private institutions are 1.20 encouraged to change their policies and practices to reflect the experiences of American 1.21 Indian people and our country's indigenous roots, culture, history, and significant 1.22
