- 1.2 relating to transportation; increasing motorcycle endorsement fees; amending
- 1.3 Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 171.06, subdivision 2a.
- 1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
- 1.5 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 171.06, subdivision 2a, is amended to read:
- 1.6 Subd. 2a. **Two-wheeled vehicle endorsement fee.** (a) The fee for any duplicate driver's
- 1.7 license obtained for the purpose of adding a two-wheeled vehicle endorsement is increased
- 1.8 by ~~\$18.50~~ \$26.50 for each first such duplicate license and ~~\$13~~ \$17 for each renewal thereof.
- 1.9 The additional fee must be paid into the state treasury and credited as follows:
- 1.10 (1) ~~\$11~~ \$19 of the additional fee for each first duplicate license, and ~~\$7~~ \$11 of the
- 1.11 additional fee for each renewal, must be credited to the motorcycle safety fund, which is
- 1.12 hereby created; and
- 1.13 (2) the remainder of the additional fee must be credited to the general fund.
- 1.14 (b) All application forms prepared by the commissioner for two-wheeled vehicle
- 1.15 endorsements must clearly state the amount of the total fee that is dedicated to the motorcycle
- 1.16 safety fund.
