1.15	(c) "Electronic cash register" means a device that keeps a register or supporting documents
1.16	through the means of an electronic device or computer system designed to record transaction
1.17	data for the purpose of computing, compiling, or processing retail sales transaction data in
1.18	whatever manner.
1.19	(d) "Phantom-ware" means hidden preinstalled or later-installed programming option
1.20	embedded in the operating system of an electronic cash register or hardwired into the
1.21	electronic cash register that can be used to create a virtual second electronic cash register
1.22	or may eliminate or manipulate transaction records that may or may not be preserved in
