1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. **DESIGNATION AND SALE OF SURPLUS STATE-OWNED REAL**

1.6 **PROPERTY; ST. PAUL.**

1.7 (a) For purposes of this act, "L'Orient Avenue property" means the real property located

1.8 at 1415 L'Orient Avenue in the city of St. Paul that was acquired by the state using money

1.9 appropriated from the COVID-19 Minnesota fund in accordance with the Legislative

1.10 COVID-19 Response Commission, Action Order number 13, signed by the commissioner

1.11 of management and budget May 7, 2020.

1.12 (b) The commissioner of administration must designate the L'Orient Avenue property

1.13 as surplus and dispose of the property in accordance with Minnesota Statutes, sections

1.14 16B.281 to 16B.287.

1.15 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
