- (a) \$18,750,000 in fiscal year 2016 and \$18,750,000 in fiscal year 2017 are appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner of agriculture for transfer to the fund created in Minnesota Statutes, section 41A.14, subdivision 2. Of these amounts:
- (1) at least \$2,000,000 each year is for agriculture rapid response under Minnesota Statutes, section 41A.14, subdivision 1, clause (2); and
