1.5BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 16B.98, is amended by adding a subdivision

1.7to read:

1.8Subd. 12. **Report to the legislature and attorney general.** A granting agency must

1.9include in a grant agreement a requirement that the grantee submit an annual report to the

1.10attorney general and to the chairs and ranking minority members of the legislative committees

1.11with jurisdiction over the granting agency. The annual report must detail the total amount

1.12of the grant awarded to the grantee, how the grant was used, and must include a copy of the

1.13grantee's most recent IRS form 990. The granting agency must provide the grantee with

1.14information on how to properly deliver the reports required by this subdivision.

1.15EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective July 1, 2023, and applies to grant

1.16agreements executed on or after that date.
