Subdivision 1. **Appropriation.** \$189,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund to the commissioner of employment and economic development for a grant to the city of Woodbury to prepare the site, construct, furnish, and equip a fully accessible and inclusive playground at the Bielenberg Sports Center in Woodbury. This appropriation is not available until at least an equal amount is committed from nonstate sources.

Subd. 2. **Bond sale.** To provide the money appropriated in subdivision 1 from the bond proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of the state in an amount up to \$189,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.

**EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
