1.1 A bill for an act  
 1.2 relating to natural resources; establishing a shooting sports facility grant  
 1.3 program; appropriating money; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota  
 1.4 Statutes, chapter 87A.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. **[87A.10] SHOOTING SPORTS FACILITY GRANTS.**

1.7 The commissioner of natural resources shall administer a program to provide  
 1.8 cost-share grants to local recreational shooting clubs for up to 50 percent of the costs  
 1.9 of developing or rehabilitating shooting sports facilities for public use. A facility  
 1.10 rehabilitated or developed with a grant under this section must be open to the general  
 1.11 public at reasonable times and for a reasonable fee on a walk-in basis.

1.12 Sec. 2. **APPROPRIATION.**

1.13 \$2,000,000 in fiscal year 2015 is appropriated from the game and fish fund to the  
 1.14 commissioner of natural resources for shooting sports facility grants under Minnesota  
 1.15 Statutes, section 87A.10.
