OFFICIAL STATUS

1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to arts and culture; appropriating money to update 25-year plan and create
1.3 a second ten-year plan for arts and cultural heritage fund; requiring a report.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. **APPROPRIATION; ARTS AND CULTURAL HERITAGE FUND**
1.6 **SECOND TEN-YEAR PLAN AND FRAMEWORK.**

1.7 (a) \$20,000 in fiscal year 2020 is appropriated from the arts and cultural heritage fund
1.8 to the commissioner of administration to work in collaboration with programs and
1.9 organizations funded through the arts and cultural heritage fund to develop a second ten-year
1.10 plan for the arts and cultural heritage fund that includes goals and measurable outcomes for
1.11 future funding. The ten-year plan must include goals and measurable outcomes that guide
1.12 the legislature in:

1.13 (1) awarding money; and

1.14 (2) addressing the needs of underserved communities.

1.15 (b) The commissioner of administration, in collaboration with recipients of arts and
1.16 cultural heritage funding, must also review and amend the 25-year framework for the arts
1.17 and cultural heritage fund to include in the purposes of the framework the importance of
1.18 American Indian history and culture to the state of Minnesota and the continuing need to
1.19 celebrate and engage communities with American Indian history, arts, and culture. The
1.20 commissioner of administration must report to the legislative committees with jurisdiction
1.21 over the arts and cultural heritage fund no later than January 15, 2020, with a second ten-year
1.22 plan and an amended 25-year framework for the arts and cultural heritage fund.
