1.1 A bill for an act
 1.2 relating to education; requiring a student who assaults a teacher to be expelled
 1.3 from school; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 121A.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. **[121A.441] EXPULSION FOR ASSAULTING A TEACHER.**

1.6 (a) A school board must expel a student who assaults a teacher. The duration of the
 1.7 expulsion is at the discretion of the school board. "Assault" has the meaning given in
 1.8 section 128C.08, subdivision 1.

1.9 (b) A student expelled under this section cannot be placed in the classroom of the
 1.10 assaulted teacher unless the teacher agrees to the placement.
