OFFICIAL STATUS

1.1 A bill for an act  
1.2 relating to capital investment; appropriating money for the C.A. Weyerhaeuser  
1.3 Museum in Morrison County; authorizing the sale and issuance of state bonds.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. **MORRISON COUNTY; C.A. WEYERHAEUSER MUSEUM.**

1.6 Subdivision 1. **Appropriation.** \$1,561,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund  
1.7 to the commissioner of employment and economic development for a grant to Morrison  
1.8 County to predesign, design, construct, furnish, and equip the renovation of the C.A.  
1.9 Weyerhaeuser Memorial Museum, home of the Morrison County Historical Society. This  
1.10 appropriation includes money for: capital improvements to provide additional interior space  
1.11 for collections and storage; replacement or upgrade of the building's mechanical systems,  
1.12 including HVAC; repairs to the building exterior, repair or replacement of windows, and  
1.13 replacement of the roof; accessibility improvements for compliance with the Americans  
1.14 with Disabilities Act (ADA); acquisition of real property adjacent to the museum; site work  
1.15 and landscaping; and other improvements and betterments of a capital nature. Morrison  
1.16 County may enter into a lease or management agreement for the museum, subject to  
1.17 Minnesota Statutes, section 16A.695.

1.18 Subd. 2. **Bond sale.** To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond  
1.19 proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of  
1.20 the state in an amount up to \$1,561,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect  
1.21 prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota  
1.22 Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.

1.23 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
