1.6BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.7Section 1. **[340A.915] ONGOING OPERATIONS.**

1.8If a fiscal biennium ends without final enactment of an appropriation to the Division

1.9of Alcohol and Gambling Enforcement for the following biennium, existing amounts

1.10remain in effect at the base level and are appropriated to the commissioner of public

1.11safety for regulatory and enforcement activities necessary to carry out the commissioner's

1.12duties and responsibilities under this chapter.

1.13**EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
