## A bill for an act

relating to finance; extending availability of fire remediation grants; amending Laws 2017, First Special Session chapter 1, article 4, section 31.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Laws 2017, First Special Session chapter 1, article 4, section 31, is amended to read:

## Sec. 31. APPROPRIATION; FIRE REMEDIATION GRANTS.

$\$ 1,392,258$ is appropriated in fiscal year 2018 from the general fund to the commissioner of public safety for grants to remediate the effects of fires in the city of Melrose on September 8, 2016. The commissioner must allocate the grants as follows:
(1) $\$ 1,296,458$ to the city of Melrose; and
(2) $\$ 95,800$ to Stearns County.

A grant recipient must use the money appropriated under this section for remediation costs, including disaster recovery, infrastructure, reimbursement for emergency personnel costs, reimbursement for equipment costs, and reimbursements for property tax abatements, incurred by public or private entities as a result of the fires. This is a onetime appropriation and is available until June 30, 20182023.

EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.
