1.6Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 169.345, is amended by adding a subdivision

1.8Subd. 6. **Pregnancy-related temporary certificates.** (a) Upon application and

1.9submission of a medical statement under subdivision 2a affirming the applicant is in the

1.10third trimester of pregnancy, the commissioner shall issue a temporary certificate under this

1.11section to the applicant. The temporary certificate is valid for up to 90 days and must

1.12prominently display the expiration date.

1.13(b) Upon application and submission of a medical statement under subdivision 2a

1.14affirming the delivery date of the applicant's child, the commissioner shall issue a temporary

1.15certificate under this section to the applicant. The temporary certificate is valid for up to 90

1.16days after the delivery date and must prominently display the expiration date.
