BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. [62Q.59] COVERAGE FOR DENTAL PROCEDURES RESULTING

FROM CANCER TREATMENT.

(a) All health plans, as defined in section 62Q.01, shall provide coverage for medically

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necessary dental procedures that are the direct result of cancer treatment, including

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chemotherapy, biotherapy, and radiation therapy.

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(b) The coverage required under this section shall include coverage for evaluations and

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examinations, laboratory assessments, medications, and treatments associated with the

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medically necessary dental procedures resulting from cancer treatment.

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EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment and

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applies to insurance contracts issued, renewed, or amended on or after that date.
