1.19	to approval by voters of the city of Waite Park at a general election.
1.20	Subd. 4. Use of tax revenues. The revenues derived from the tax authorized under
1.21	subdivision 1 must be used by the city of Waite Park to pay the costs of collecting and
1.22	administering the tax, and to pay for the costs of local law enforcement, fire department,
